You will need to use 12- point font in Arial or Calibri. Take your time and make sure you address the information above. The essay needs to be no more than 1,000 words.

Attach the essay, two letters of recommendation and a copy of your official high school transcript (**with social security number blacked out**) to this completed application. The application must be returned to your guidance office on or before Friday, March 17, 2017. Letters of recommendation should not come from members of the applicant's family.

### Permission to release transcript
