ESSAY

The essay portion is an essential part of FBP's scholarship application and will be **strongly** considered in determining the scholarship recipients. The essay needs to be well thought out. This is your chance to show the reviewers who you are and why you deserve the FBP S.T.E.M. Scholarship. The essay needs to be written solely by the applicant and encompass the following:

- Why you should be selected to receive the Fluor-BWXT Portsmouth S.T.E.M. Scholarship
- What your plans are while attending college
- What your future plans are upon graduation from college
- Financial need
- Any special circumstances that make you an ideal candidate for this scholarship

You will need to use 12- point font in Arial or Calibri. Take your time and make sure you address the information above. The essay needs to be no more than 1,000 words.

Attach the essay, two letters of recommendation and a copy of your official high school transcript (**WITH SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER BLACKED OUT**) to this completed application. The application must be returned to your guidance office on or before Friday, February 15, 2019. Letters of recommendation should not come from members of the applicant's family. **(NO STAPLES AND NO DOUBLE SIDED APPLICATIONS PLEASE)**

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Permission to release transcript
