X-326 D&D *(Decontamination & Decommissioning)*

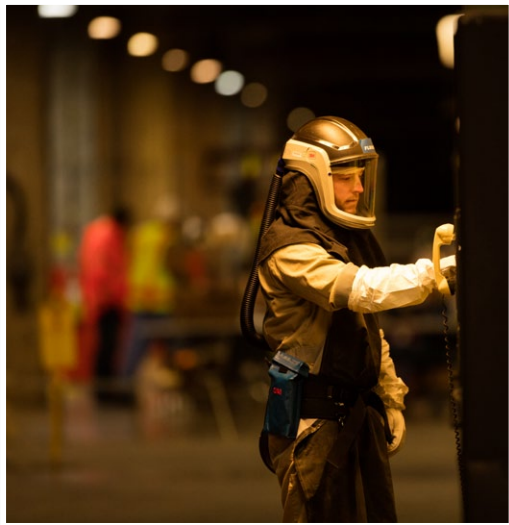
The X-326 Process Building

originally produced highly enriched uranium for use in the nation's defense program and nuclear Naval vessels.

The X-326 is the First Process Building

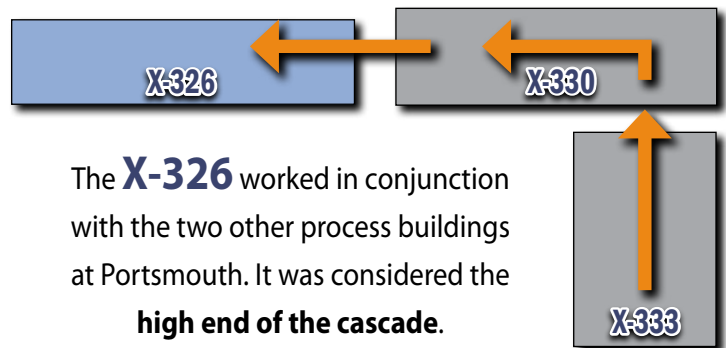
at PORTS to undergo deactivation in preparation for demolition.

Since 2012, more than **7,000** process components have been carefully removed.



2017 Goal - 'Cold & Dark' and Ready for Demolition

- Downgrade facility from a Cat 2 Nuclear Facility
- Downgrade security
- Utility isolation and relocation



The X-326 worked in conjunction with the two other process buildings at Portsmouth. It was considered the **high end of the cascade.**

The X-326 Building is approximately 1/2 mile long.

One Half Mile • 880 Yards • 2,640 Feet • 7 Football Fields
