Subject: Expression of Interest - PORTS Utilities Re-Route

Fluor-BWXT Portsmouth LLC (FBP) anticipates the need for a contractor to re-route overhead utilities at the former Department of Energy Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plant (PORTS) near Piketon, Ohio. Consequently, a Request for Proposal is expected to be issued in the near future to firms found capable of supporting the project. Background

The PORTS site is an approximately 3777-acre facility located in southern Ohio approximately 25 miles north of Portsmouth, Ohio. The Gaseous Diffusion Plant site is undergoing remediation pursuant to the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA). Fluor-BWXT Portsmouth is the Department of Energy's prime contractor performing this remediation work.

Project Overview

The contractor will re-route overhead utilities at the PORTS site in accordance with drawings provided by FBP. Utilities include electrical power lines, fiber optic and copper communication lines, fire alarm loop and fire alarm cables. FBP anticipates the general scope of the project to include:

- Installation of approximately 50 Class 2 – 65 ft Power Poles
- Relocation/re-routing of approximately 11,000 feet of 13.8kV power cables
- Re-routing or installation of approximately 10,000 feet of communication lines and fire alarm looks
- Removal of existing fence lighting and replacement with LED fixtures
- Installation of pole mounted transformers
- Demolition and removal of approximately 80 utility poles

FBP intends to award a single firm fixed price contract to one contractor for completion of this scope. FBP expects to issue a Request for Proposal to interested firms in early March of 2019 and issue an award to the selected contractor in May 2019. Interested firms are advised that all contractors performing electrical related work on the PORTS site must be a Licensed Electrical Contractor in the State of Ohio or Reciprocal States, issued through the Ohio Construction Licensing Board (OCILB).
