1	Section C, Part 2 on Page 14 of the RFP has the Labor Categories listed (001-009). In section L under Volume 1 – Technical /Management Proposal subpart (b) minimal requirements lists Essential Subcontractor Personnel and qualifications. In Section M – Evaluation Criterion 1 – Personnel Qualifications and Experience requests resumes for the following: Senior Project Manager/Project Manager, Senior Scientist/Scientist II, and Principal Regulatory Specialist. The first two essential subcontractor personnel are four separate positions listed in the Labor Categories. Are bidders permitted to select one labor category and provide one resume? For example, provide a resume for Senior Scientist rather than Scientist II.	Yes.
2	Is there a maximum page count for Volume 1 - Technical/Management Proposal?	No, there is not a maximum page count for Volume 1, however per Section L.3, files being emailed must be less than 10 MB each.
3	Can an individual be proposed for more than one key position?	Yes.
4	Please confirm that the small business size standard for this procurement is 750 employees.	Yes, according to the U.S. Small Business Administration, NAICS code 562910 footnote 14 for Environmental Remediation, small business size standard is \$22M and/or 750 employees.
5	Does FBP intend to make a single award or multiple awards?	Per Section H.84, FBP has the right to issue multiple awards under this contract.
6	Are letters of commitment for the key personnel required to be included in the proposal?	Yes.
7	As the prime bidder, the contractor will provide information required in Section K – Representations, Certifications, and Other Statements of Offerors of the RFP.
