Questions & Answers

- 1. Will transition occur for all current subcontracted Rad Techs & Industrial Hygiene Support serving the project, both union and non-union workers, of current subcontractors?**

It is the intent of FBP to transition all current Union subcontracted Rad Techs & Industrial Hygiene Support to the new contract. There are not any non-Union workers.

- 2. How do we handle pricing on Option Year 2 after CBA expires?**

All proposed rates are **fixed for the duration** of the Contract (Base Year, Option Year 1 and Option Year 2) and should be calculated by applying an escalation factor based on historical wage information from the Local Laborer's 83 Union. Only an unusual event occurring that can't be estimated will be justification to increase the rates provided in B.2 above.

- 3. What is the designated transition period for the transition to a new Award?**

FBP's estimate would be two weeks to a month.

- 4. Can the site transportation be clarified?**

All necessary site transportation is currently provided by FBP.

- 5. Who is responsible for paying the PTO for the transitioned employees?**

- 6. Will the current QA surveillance personnel be transitioned or stay with their current employer?**

The awardee will be responsible for providing any required QA surveillance with any costs being built into the proposed rates.
